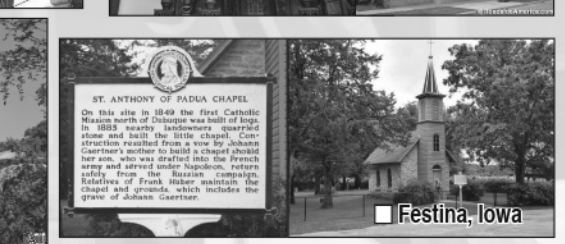
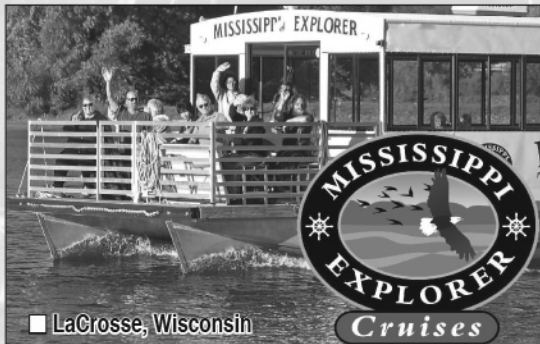
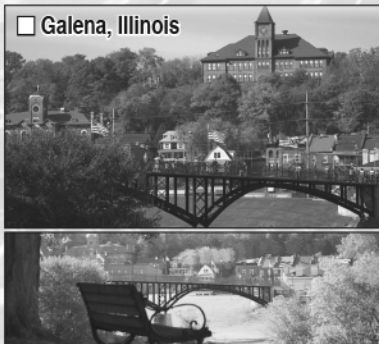

■ DAY 1: Tuesday, April 28th

Welcome to Galena, Illinois - Along the Mississippi River. Visit the historic sites and savor locally grown, award-winning wines in the vineyards or shop for keepsakes. Includes a step on tour of this quaint Illinois town. Overnight stay at the beautiful Grand Harbor Hotel in Galena, Illinois. Delicious evening meal included.

■ DAY 2: Wednesday, April 29th

This morning arrive in the quaint city of Guttenberg, Iowa. - Along the Mississippi River. Tour the Lock and visit the famous Lockmaster's Heritage House and Museum overlooking the river. A beautiful view to Pikes Peak State Park near McGregor - Overlooking the Mississippi River. Stop to take pictures at Prairie du Shein - Along the Mississippi River. Stay for lunch at our Lady of Guadalupe Shrine and tour included. Our Lady of Guadalupe is a remarkable location in La Crosse! Nestled among 100 acres of Wisconsin bluffs, you will find the magnificent Shrine Church where Holy Mass is celebrated daily, the beautiful Votive Candle Chapel, outdoor devotional areas including Stations of the Cross and Rosary Walk, the Memorial to the Unborn, the Pilgrim Center which provides information for visitors, the Flores Mariae Gift Shop, and the Culina Mariana Cafe. Arrive at the Hotel Best Western on the River Front in La Crosse, WI. Experience a late afternoon cruise aboard the "Mississippi Explorer Cruise." Enjoy an evening picnic aboard ship - included. Don't settle for an "Up, Down, Turn-Around Cruise." Join us for an interactive river boat tour through the wild and scenic backwaters of the Mississippi River's Wildlife Refuge. Wildlife Cruises will take you within feet of beautiful backwater riverbanks, bald eagle nests, beaver lodges, turtle filled logs, muskrat huts, blooming lotus, water lilies and more!

■ DAY 3: Thursday, April 30th

Enjoy a step-on guided tour of Clarissa, WI, then cross the river into Minnesota. Drive through the beautiful apple orchards of La Crescent. Apple Blossom Scenic Drive: Drive the second most scenic overlook in Minnesota through neighboring La Crescent, the "Apple Capital" of Minnesota. More than 1,400 acres include 12 apple orchards in La Crescent. Take in the spectacular view of the colorful tree-line bluffs, decorative rolling hills and the majestic Mississippi River; A must see in Autumn, as fall colors peak. Enjoy a tasty noon lunch at the Harmony House - in Harmony Minnesota. Harmony is home to the largest Amish community in Minnesota. Harmony was settled in the late 19th century with the coming of the railroad. "Old Order" Amish families began arriving in the 1970's, taking advantage of the low land prices to establish large farms. Today, horse-drawn buggies share the road with fast moving cars. Step-on guided tours of the Amish countryside. Tour Vesterheim Norwegian American Museum - Tour both indoor and outdoor sections of the museum. Vesterheim is the most comprehensive museum in the US dedicated to a single immigrant group. \$7.00 entry fee. Evening meal included, overnight in Decorah, IA.

■ DAY 4: Friday, May 1st

Visit Spillville and the Billy Clock Museum. Antonin Dvorak spent the summer of 1893 in Spillville making final corrections on his "New World Symphony." Working on other compositions and relaxing. He played the organ at St. Wenceslaus Church and took many walks through Riverside Park, the present site of the Dvorak Memorial, a stone honoring the Czech composer. The Billy Clock Museum and Antonin Dvorak Exhibit is at 323 S. Main St. The collection of hand carved clocks is housed in the brick-front former residence of noted Czech composer Antonin Dvorak. The timepieces made by Frank and Joseph Bily (BEE-lee) include the elaborate American Pioneer History Clock, which stands more than 10 feet tall and has 57 bas-relief panels depicting pioneer life. The second floor contains a tribute to Dvorak. Visit St. Anthony of Padua Chapel - World's smallest church, Festina, IA. Noon stay for lunch and shopping in Amana.
