ITINERARY

July 26 - Hansen Wheel & Wagon / Pierre, SD

Welcome to your Adventurous North Dakota Tour! Meet us at one of our many convenient pick-up points as we begin to make our way north. Early this afternoon we visit the Hansen Wheel & Wagon Shop located near Mitchell, SD. This tour, not available to most travelers, takes us through this very unique family owned and operated shop that builds authentic horse-drawn stagecoaches, wagons and carriages. Upon arrival in Pierre, South Dakota's state capital city, we spend a bit of time to explore the South Dakota State Historical Society before coming together for an evening meal at a local favorite restaurant. **(D)**

July 27 - Theodore Roosevelt National Park / Medora Musical & Fondue

Today's travels take us north to Medora and Theodore Roosevelt National Park! This rugged, scenic and remote National Park honors the President that helped shape a conservation policy that we still benefit from today. We won't have to search far to find bison, elk and deer roaming the prairies and badlands in which they call home. Tonight features great food and entertainment at the Medora Musical. A North Dakota family tradition, the Medora Musical is performed outdoors live, under the Badlands sky in the 2,900-seat Burning Hills Amphitheater. The show is dedicated to President Theodore Roosevelt's time in the Badlands and to the Spirit of the Old West! **(B, D)**

July 28 - Dakota Synfuels Power Plant / Scandinavian Heritage Park

This morning features a tour of the Dakota Gasification Company Synfuels Power Plant in Beulah, the only commercial-scale coal gasification facility in the United States that manufactures natural gas. In Minot, we visit the Scandinavian Heritage Park, where you will find a world of Scandinavian history like none other. Step inside a real Stabbur, explore their amazing full-scale replica Stave Church and admire the 25-foot-tall Swedish Dala Horse! **(B, D)**

July 29 - International Peace Gardens / Jamestown, ND

Continue even further north this morning to the renowned International Peace Garden. Founded in 1932 and nestled in the heart of the Turtle Mountains, the Peace Garden is nearly 2,400 acres of indoor and outdoor gardens, displays, hiking trails, scenic drives and a museum. Because the Peace Garden sits on the border of Canada and the United States, you will need a Passport or government-issued ID with copy of birth certificate. A picnic lunch will also be included. Later this afternoon we arrive in Jamestown, ND – home to the world's largest buffalo monument and Frontier Village, making time for both stops as well as an evening meal together. **(B, L, D)**

July 30 - Return Home

Say goodbye to North Dakota this morning and your fellow travelers this evening as you arrive back at your initial pick up points with many fond memories of Adventurous North Dakota! (B)
