ITINERARY

Pre-Departure

If applicable, due to early flight times, pre-departure accommodations in Omaha are included. Complete details will be sent with your final travel documents.

Day 1 - Depart Omaha / Arrive in Boston

Meet us at one of our pick-up points as we make our way to Omaha's Eppley Airfield and connect to our flight to Boston, Massachusetts. Welcome to New England - where autumn is radiant and beaming with beautiful colors of red, orange and gold! Be met by our local tour director and motorcoach and transfer to our overnight accommodations before enjoying a welcome dinner together. (D)

Day 2 - Boston's Historic Freedom Trail / Berkshires

This morning enjoy a guided tour of Boston, known fondly as "Bean Town." We'll tour along the Freedom Trail viewing such sites as the Old South Meeting House, Kings Chapel and Burying Ground, Park Street Church and the Old State House. Perhaps even make a picture stop at Bull and Finch Pub - known to most as "Cheers." See beautiful Boston Common, the oldest public garden in America and enjoy free time on your own to explore Faneuil Hall and its many shops and restaurants. This afternoon enjoy the beautiful colors as we travel through the Pioneer Valley to the Berkshire Hills! We'll also visit the famed Norman Rockwell Museum in the beautiful town of Stockbridge before dinner together this evening. (B, D)

Day 3 - Apple Barn "Taste of Vermont" / **Hildene-The Lincoln Family Home**

Head to Bennington, VT to visit the Apple Barn for a unique "Taste of Vermont" experience! Enjoy a tour to the top of their 300-acre orchard for spectacular views of southern Vermont, followed by a slice of their homemade apple pie a la mode! Continue onto the beautiful village of Manchester for a visit to historic Hildene-The Lincoln Family Home. Hildene was built by Abraham Lincoln's son, Robert in 1905 as his ancestral home. We'll have a lunch in the pavilion and then tour the restored 24-room Georgian Revival mansion, gardens and carriage barn. This afternoon also features beautiful scenery as we make our way for our two-night stay in South Burlington, VT. (B, L, D)

Day 4 - Rock of Ages / Vermont Maple Sugar House

Another spectacular day touring around Vermont enjoying the splendid foliage await! Begin with a visit to the Rock of Ages Granite Quarry. Our own guide will greet us for a private tour around the 50-acre, 600-foot-deep quarry. Continue to Morse, SugarWorks, a traditional Maple Sugar house, for a demonstration and sugaron-snow tasting. Stop in Vermont's state capital, Montpelier, for free time for lunch on your own before we head to the beautiful village of Stowe and the Stowe Mercantile for authentic New England items. Finish off the day with a stop at The Vermont Annex which houses Cabot Cheese, Lake Champlain Chocolates and Smuggler's Notch Distillery for great samples. (B, D)

Day 5 - Mount Washington Hotel, Lunch & Cog Railway

This morning finds us in the majestic White Mountains of New Hampshire. Our first stop is the Mount Washington Hotel, a grand masterpiece of Spanish Renaissance architecture. Enjoy a guided tour of this magnificent hotel followed by a delicious lunch in the grand dining room. Then, venture to the Mount Washington Cog Railway for an unforgettable and exciting railing experience. In 1869, the Cog Railway was an engineering marvel, a technology of toothed cog gears, rack rails and tilted boilers. Enjoy a rare glimpse of this world gone by while enjoying spectacular views traveling up some of the steepest railroad tracks in existence. (B, L)

Day 6 - Lake Winnipesaukee Cruise / Castle in the Clouds

Another spectacular day touring through New Hampshire's Lakes Region and White Mountains. This morning, board our scenic cruise on Lake Winnipesaukee - the state's largest and most beautiful lake. Following the cruise, enjoy free time and lunch on your own in the charming lakeside village of Wolfeboro. Later, we'll visit the Castle in the Clouds, set high atop the Ossipee mountain range. This New Hampshire icon is wonderfully preserved to give a real sense of how country life was lived by the fabulously wealthy at the turn of the century. This afternoon we'll tour along one of the country's most scenic byways, the Kancamagus Highway, en route back to our hotel. (B, D)

Day 7 - Penobscot Narrows Bridge Observatory / Mount Desert Island

This morning, sit back and relax as we depart for the beautiful state of Maine. Visit Fort Knox State historic site, one of America's bestpreserved examples of seacoast fortifications constructed in the 1800's. We'll also make a stop at the Penobscot Narrows Observatory, the tallest bridge open to the public in the world! This afternoon, arrive to beautiful Mount Desert Island and check into our two-night accommodations right along the ocean before enjoying an evening meal together in one of Bar Harbor's fine restaurants. (B, D)

Day 8 - Acadia National Park / Whale Watching Cruise

Today features a tour through one of America's beautiful and treasured National Parks, Acadia National Park. Visit thunder hole along with other scenic picture stops and travel to the top of Cadillac Mountain for spectacular views below. Mid-day, embark on an exciting Whale Watching Cruise out on Frenchman's Bay. Be sure to have your camera's ready as we witness these magnificent mammals feed and frolic in their ocean playground. After the cruise, enjoy free time for dinner on your own in scenic Bar Harbor. (B)

Day 9 - Kennebunkport / Lobster Cruise

Continue down Maine's coastline, briefly stopping in Portland's Old Port district and on to the popular summer resort of Kennebunkport. Its quaint setting appeals to artists, writers and presidents! Our scenic drive takes us along the ocean to Walker's Point, passing the wellknown summer home of past president George HW Bush. Continue to the seaside village of Ogunquit, meaning "beautiful place by the sea." Here we board our cruise for a first-hand lobstering experience! Then its on to the villages of York with a visit to one of the most photographed lighthouses in the country - Cape Neddick Light, popularly known as "Nubble." During our last evening together, we partake in a traditional down east Clambake for a chance to try delicious Maine Lobster! (B, D)

Day 10 - Return Home

Check-out and make our way to Boston's Logan International Airport for our return flight back to Omaha, taking home with us wonderful stories of our foliage New England experience and treasured memories that will last a lifetime!
