ITINERARY

April 25 – Travel Day / Laramie, WY

Meet your Moostash Joe Tour Director and Driver at one of our many convenient pick-up points and head west! Our travels take us to Laramie, WY where we'll all enjoy an evening welcome dinner together at Wyoming's Rib & Chop House. **(D)**

April 26 – Bonneville Salt Flats / West Wendover, NV

We continue west today through the Wyoming countryside and across Utah. This afternoon, make a stop to view Utah's amazing Bonneville Salt Flats, stretching over 30,000 acres and the perfect spot for achieving land speed records. Upon arrival at the Montego Bay Resort & Casino, enjoy an evening meal and an opportunity to try your luck! **(B, D)**

April 27 – Donner Memorial State Park / Lake Tahoe, CA

We travel through Nevada, making a stop at the Donner Memorial State Park & Museum. Located in the beautiful Sierra Nevada's, we explore the park and museum along with their new exhibits telling the stories of those who emigrated to California from the east in the 1800's and the Donner Party. Later, travel along sky-blue Lake Tahoe and finish the day in South Lake Tahoe with an evening to enjoy at your leisure. **(B)**

April 28 – Scenic CA-88 / Yosemite Westgate Lodge

After a leisurely morning, continue through the Sierra Nevada Mountains on beautiful California Highway 88, dotted with picturesque lakes and scenic overlooks and recognized as one of the most scenic drives in America. Spend a bit of free time in the quaint community of Sonora before checking in to our two-night accommodations near the west gate of Yosemite National Park and enjoy an evening meal together near our hotel. **(B, D)**

April 29 – Yosemite National Park

An incredible opportunity to spend the entire day in stunning Yosemite National Park! This true national treasure, located in California's Sierra Nevada Mountains, is known for its giant, ancient sequoia trees, the granite cliffs of El Capitan and Half Dome and the towering Bridalveil Falls. Upon arrival, we board our open air tram for our two-hour guided Yosemite Valley Floor Tour as an introduction before giving you the rest of the afternoon to explore Yosemite as you wish. Choose to walk through their series of trails, shop the village stores or simply gaze out at the surrounding natural beauty. **(B)**

April 30 – Viansa Sonoma Winery / San Francisco, CA

Head out of the mountains this morning towards wine country! A great opportunity awaits to see and taste the wine from this world-famous fertile stretch of land. Learn all about the area and its renowned wine-making over a delicious lunch with wine tasting and gorgeous views at Viansa Sonoma Winery. A short afternoon drive takes us across the iconic Golden Gate Bridge and into San Francisco, where you'll have plenty of free time to explore on your own and enjoy your great location right along Fisherman's Wharf and famed Pier 39 this evening. **(B, L)**

May 1 – San Francisco / Monterey, CA

This morning we meet our local tour guide for a step-on guided city tour of San Francisco. See all of the must-see spots in "The City by the Bay" with local commentary and the convenience of group travel. After our tour, we continue through Silicon Valley, ending in gorgeous Monterey, CA. Here, you'll have a free evening to spend in Downtown Monterey or along the upscale Cannery Row, Monterey's premier shopping and dining destination. **(B)**

May 2 – 17-Mile Drive / Hearst Castle

Another highlight of the tour for many of you, this morning we take the world-famous 17-Mile Drive along the Monterey Peninsula, making stops to see the crashing waves of the Pacific Ocean, the iconic Lone Cypress and even a stop at renowned Pebble Beach Golf Links! Spend some time here to browse the unique shops, watch a few golfers battle their nerves on the first tee and walk in the footsteps of golf's legends. This afternoon travel back in time when we stop to tour Hearst Castle, the enormous mansion built in 1919 sitting high atop the Pacific Ocean. Our day ends in Grover Beach, CA and an evening meal at a local restaurant. **(B, D)**

May 3 – Amtrak Pacific Surfliner / Santa Monica Pier

This morning, ride California's coastal & scenic Amtrak Pacific Surfliner from Grover Beach to Ventura! Venture where passenger vehicles simply cannot travel on this three-hour ride along the breathtaking Pacific Coast. Then, we head to the nearby Santa Monica Pier for a bit of free time for lunch and to explore the famed 100-year-old pier. From here, continue through Los Angeles to the desert, where we'll be overnight in Palm Springs, CA and free time to enjoy your central location at the Palm Mountain Resort & Spa. **(B)**

May 4 – Las Vegas, NV / Mesquite, NV

Enjoy today's drive through the southern California desert, making a stop to try your luck in Las Vegas and onto Mesquite. Enjoy some down time this evening and dinner at the Casablanca Resort, where we'll be overnight. **(B, D)**

May 5 – Zion National Park

Today includes a visit to another one of America's iconic landscapes, Zion National Park! Located in southwestern Utah and one of the most visited parks in the United States, Zion is known for its massive, steep, red sandstone cliffs and unique array of plants and animals.
