ITINERARY

Day 1 - Welcome / Travel Day

Welcome to your Moostash Joe Tour! Travel today through Iowa, Illinois and to South Bend, IN, where we'll be overnight and an opportunity for you to enjoy the evening at your leisure.

Day 2 - Cleveland, OH / Lake Erie Sunset Dinner Cruise

We acquaint ourselves with Cleveland, OH early this afternoon on our local, step-on guided city tour. Learn about the city's storied history of manufacturing and see their numerous steps toward revitalizing their lakefront and downtown area. This evening, in Erie, PA, relax and enjoy a Lake Erie Sunset Dinner Cruise aboard The Victorian Princess - Erie's only authentic paddle wheeler! (B, D)

Day 3 - Catskill Mountains / Clove Creek Dinner Theater

Today's drive takes us through the beautiful Catskill Mountains en route to Fishkill, NY, our home for the night. Another great evening is planned at the Clove Creek Dinner Theater featuring a gourmet menu, talented actors, plenty of laughs and certainly an evening to remember. (B, D)

Day 4 - FDR Museum & Library / Rhode Island

This morning we meet our local, step-on guide for a tour of the Poughkeepsie area en route to tour the Franklin D. Roosevelt Museum & Library as well as the home of Eleanor Roosevelt in nearby Hyde Park. The museum features special exhibits and rarely seen artifacts telling the story of the 32nd president of the United States. Then, continue to make our way towards the coast for our one-night stay in Rhode Island - otherwise known as "The Ocean State" and an evening to spend as you wish. (B)

Day 5 - Breakers Mansion / Cape Cod

Meet our local, step-on guide this morning and take in the rugged beauty of Ten-Mile Ocean Drive and the fabulous mansions along tree-lined Bellevue Avenue. Tour the Breakers Mansion, the grandest of Newport's summer "cottages" and a symbol of the Vanderbilt family's social and financial preeminence. Enjoy free time in the historic waterfront downtown area with cobblestone shopping wharves and specialty restaurants before continuing onto Massachusetts and Cape Cod. Here, we meet our local, step-on guide, making a stop at the Cape Cod Canal Visitor's Center along with sightseeing to include Village Green, the Great Salt Marsh, a Cranberry Bog and Cape Cod Bay. Along the way, hear stories of the Puritans, Quakers and the First Church of Christ. Then, check-in to our home for the next four nights in Mid-Cape and enjoy dinner together this evening. (B, D)

Day 6 - Provincetown / Whale Watching Excursion

Meet our local, step-on guide this morning and travel the Old King's Highway, a scenic byway winding through centuries of Cape Cod History, including the Eastham Windmill, a Cape Cod Lighthouse and a visit to the Cape Cod National Seashore Visitor's Center. Sand dunes and the ocean surround you as you approach "Land's End" -Provincetown - at the extreme tip of Cape Cod. Enjoy free time here for lunch and to explore before our amazing Whale Watching excursion! Travel into the natural habitat and try to spot Humpback, Minke and Fin Whales, as well as other marine life, all while an on-board naturalist will introduce you to everything you see. For those that wish, you may choose to stay on dry land for a Dune Tour excursion and a ride through the protected lands of the Cape Cod National Seashore, the largest protected coastline in the country. Day 7 - Martha's Vineyard / Lobster Dinner

Meet our local, step-on guide this morning and travel to Woods Hole for our ferry to Martha's Vineyard! Upon arrival, our guide will take you on a Down Island Tour, where we learn about the history and lifestyles of the islanders as you pass through the picturesque villages. Enjoy free time for lunch and a stroll in the historic whaling town of Edgartown as well as time to explore the village of Oak Bluffs with its brightly painted cottages and decorative "gingerbread" trim. Our day ends back on the mainland with a mouthwatering, fresh Lobster Dinner! (B, D)

Day 8 - Plymouth 400

Once again, meet our local, step-on guide and travel this morning to America's Hometown - Plymouth, MA. Plymouth is the place to be in 2020, as they're celebrating the 400th Anniversary of the Mayflower Voyage and the founding of Plymouth Colony. You won't want to miss this quadricentennial of national and international significance! A picture stop will be made at the Monument to our Forefather's, the largest solid granite monument in the United States. Make stops at Plymouth Rock, the traditional site of disembarkation of the Pilgrims and Mayflower II, a reproduction of the ship that brought the Pilgrims to the New World. Enjoy free time for lunch and time to shop Plymouth's neat waterfront area before boarding our Lobster Tales Cruise! The on-board naturalist will educate us about the many creatures that live in Plymouth Harbor and how lobsters are harvested from their natural environment. Later, spend some time at Plimoth Plantation, the first permanent European settlement in southern New England. Our day finishes over a Traditional Turkey Dinner with all the fixings along with a "Dress a Pilgrim" demonstration. (B, D)

Day 9 - United States Military Academy / Scranton, PA

Say goodbye to beautiful Cape Cod this morning as we start to make our way west. In the afternoon we take a guided tour of the United States Military Academy at West Point. This 90 minute tour will offer unique insight into life as a Cadet at the Academy. Continue to Scranton, PA where we'll be overnight. (B)

Day 10 - Lackawanna Coal Mine / Kent, OH

This morning we head 300 feet beneath the surface on our tour of Lackawanna Coal Mine. At a constant 53 degrees year round, see where and how they worked to heat a nation. Enjoy the gorgeous autumn drive through the rolling hills of central Pennsylvania the rest of the day on our way to the Cleveland/Akron metro. (B)

Day 11 - Princeton, IL

Continue west today, stopping to enjoy lunch together before finishing our day in Princeton, IL where we'll be overnight. (B, L)

Day 12 - Return Home
