# September 28 - Welcome / Chicago Metro

## October 1 - Toronto / CN Tower

Today we acquaint ourselves with Toronto, the capital city of Ontario and most populous city in Canada, with our local step-on guide. See its must-see sights and learn all about Toronto, recognized as one of the most multicultural and cosmopolitan cities in the world. For lunch, we head up the iconic 1,815-foot tall CN Tower to 360 Restaurant for incredible birds-eye views and delicious food. **(B, L)** 

#### October 2 - Ottawa, Canada

Drive along Lake Ontario this morning en route to Ottawa, the capital city of Canada. Upon arrival we meet our local step-on guide to take us around the city, showing us the nation's Capital, the Prime Minister's Residence, the Rockcliffe District, Byward Market and much more. We'll also tour Rideau Hall, home of the Governor General of Canada and home away from home for visiting dignitaries. Our evening meal tonight is at Canal Ritz featuring the best views of Ottawa's beautiful and historic Rideau Canal. The remainder of your evening is free to enjoy our great downtown location. **(B, D)** 

# October 3 - Quebec City, Canada

Continue east today to Quebec City, the capital city of Quebec and our home for the next two nights. Upon arrival, enjoy lunch and free time on your own in historic Place Royale in Old Quebec. This afternoon we familiarize ourselves with Quebec City with our local step-on guide including The Plains of Abraham, Cape Diamond, The Joan of Arc Garden, Parliament, Place d'Armes, Chateau Frontenac and much more. We know you'll come to find Quebec City and its cityscape as some of the most striking French and European architecture you've ever seen! This evening is free for you to enjoy Old Quebec, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the only fortified city north of Mexico. **(B)** 

# October 4 - St. Anne de Beaupre and Island of Orleans

Today enjoy a full day St. Anne de Beaupre and Island of Orleans Tour! Drive along the old King's Road including stops at Montmorency Falls, the Copper Museum, Marie's Outdoor Breadoven, the famous Ste-Anne de Beaupre shrine and a tour of the Island of Orleans with a stop at the quaint Chocolaterie! Dinner comes with traditional music tonight at Chemin Du Roy, located in the woods just a few miles from Quebec City. **(B, D)** 

#### October 5 - Montreal, Canada

A morning drive takes us to Montreal, the most populous city in Quebec and second most in Canada. We meet our step-on guide for our afternoon tour of Montreal to include Notre-Dame Basilica, Ste-Catherine Street, St-Helen Island, Mont-Royal, St-Joseph's Oratory, The Old Port, Place Jacques Cartier and much more. Spend the night just outside of Montreal in Cornwall, where we'll enjoy an evening meal together at our hotel. **(B, D)** 

# October 6 - Travel Day

Today we start to make our way back, traveling back across Ontario and across the United States/Canadian border late this afternoon. Sit back, relax and take in the beautiful autumn scenery.
