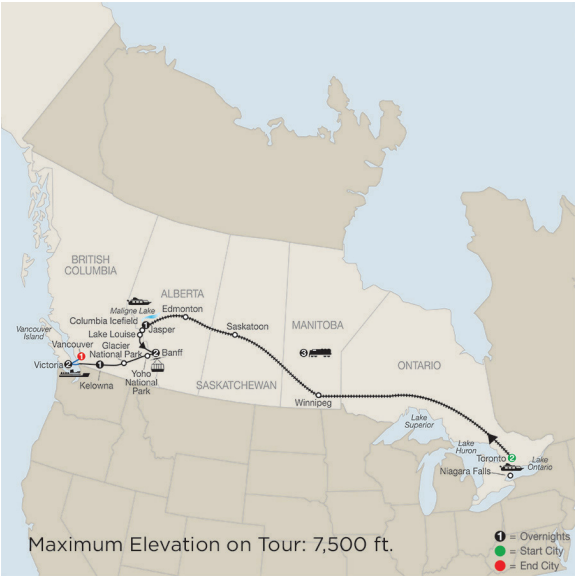

ITINERARY

May 18 – Depart Omaha / Arrive in Toronto

Meet us this morning at one of our many convenient pick-up points as we make our way to Omaha’s Eppley Airfield, where we board our connecting flight to Toronto, Ontario, Canada. Upon arrival, our private deluxe motor coach will be waiting to take you to your downtown accommodations for your two-night stay. Here, your Local Tour Director will prepare you for your upcoming adventure! You are free to spend the rest of the evening at your leisure.

May 19 – Niagara Falls / CN Tower

This morning, drive along the shores of Lake Ontario to Niagara Falls. Here, enjoy a Niagara Falls sightseeing cruise for a thrilling boat ride to view the thundering falls from river level! Then, make your way back to Toronto for dinner and amazing views atop the 1,815-foot-tall CN Tower. **(B, D)**

**NOTE:** Operation of the Niagara Falls sightseeing cruise is subject to favorable weather and/or river conditions. When weather is unfavorable, a walking tour through the scenic tunnels will be substituted.

May 20 – Toronto / VIA Rail – The Canadian

Enjoy a morning sightseeing tour of Toronto and free time to explore downtown. This afternoon, we make our way to Union Station for The Canadian, VIA Rail’s premier transcontinental train. Spend the next three days and nights on this classic trip across Canada’s heartland. Your Sleeper Plus class rail cars are refurbished art-deco cars from the 1950’s. Domed observation cars let you enjoy views of the Canadian countryside as you roll past Ontario’s landscapes. All meals on-board are included, and you won’t want to miss any of them, as the chef offers a tempting array of soups, salads, main courses and desserts! **(B, D)**

**NOTE:** On VIA Rail, beds in your private cabin are arranged by day in arm chair style. By night, beds are converted to upper and lower bunk-bed-style arrangement. Guests must be able to climb a ladder to reach the upper bed. Also, train travel is subject to unforeseen delays.

May 21 – The Canadian / Winnipeg, Manitoba

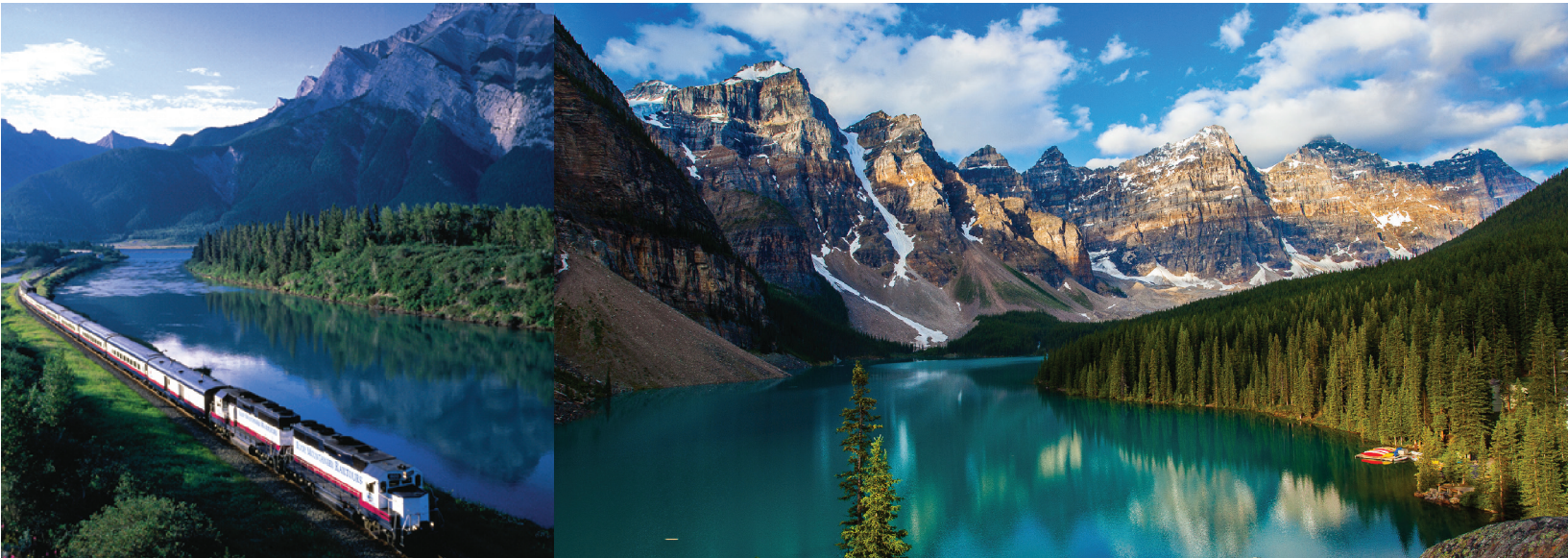
Watch the scenic countryside from your windows as you relax in first-class in your refurbished cars! Travel past the sparkling lakes and sun-dappled forests of Ontario. Try the observation dome for unparalleled views or enjoy quiet conversation in one of the comfortable lounges. Manitoba is known for its endless golden prairies and vast cultivated fields. In the late evening, we arrive in Manitoba’s capital city of Winnipeg, where you may choose to disembark the train. Upon re-boarding, we continue west into Saskatchewan. **(B, L, D)**

May 22 – The Canadian / Saskatchewan

Continue through the prairies and winding rivers of Manitoba and Saskatchewan. View the ever-changing landscape with ease and comfort as you meet and mingle with fellow passengers or enjoy freshly prepared meals that showcase Canadian cuisine and regional specialties. **(B, L, D)**

May 23 – The Canadian / Jasper, Alberta

Travel from Saskatoon to Jasper as the train roughly parallels the famed Yellowhead Route, Canada’s historic trail of westward expansion. This afternoon, our time on The Canadian ends as we arrive in Jasper for local sightseeing. Later today, enjoy an excursion to beautiful Maligne Lake and a fully-narrated cruise to Spirit Island. **(Brunch)**



May 24 – Columbia Icefield / Lake Louise

This morning, travel through Jasper National Park on Icefields Parkway to the Columbia Icefield for a thrilling Ice Explorer Ride. Climb Sunwapta Pass to savor stunning vistas of alpine meadows, waterfalls and massive glaciers. Next, stop at magnificent Lake Louise, whose green-blue waters form a perfect mirror reflection of Mount Victoria. Continue onto Banff, where we’ll be overnight. **(B, D)**

May 25 – Banff

Our morning sightseeing in Banff includes the Bow River and Falls. The remainder of the day is at your leisure to enjoy this beautiful area. Consider an optional helicopter flightseeing trip for a bird’s-eye view of the Rockies. **(B)**

May 26 – Yoho National Park / Kelowna, British Columbia

This morning, travel through the spectacular beauty of Yoho National Park, one of Canada’s most popular recreational areas and site of pre-Cambrian fossil finds. Then, on to Canada’s Glacier National Park, where our motor coach climbs 4,379-foot-high Rogers Pass, a perfect spot for photos of the surrounding mountain cliffs and glaciers. Continue to the resort city of Kelowna, attractively set on the shores of Okanagan Lake. The remainder of the evening is at leisure to explore on your own. **(B)**

May 27 – Butchart Gardens / Victoria, British Columbia

This morning we catch a BC Ferry to Vancouver Island and the very British “Garden City” of Victoria. Upon arrival, visit world-famous Butchart Gardens. Then, we take a tour of Victoria including the gardens of Beacon Hill Park, the Fairmont Empress Hotel, Bastion Square and Thunderbird Park. After dinner and over dessert this evening, enjoy a private presentation with a local storyteller and historian who will entertain you with stories of the city’s interesting characters and colorful events. **(B, D)**

May 28 – Victoria, British Columbia

Today is at leisure for independent sightseeing and shopping. Your Tour Director may suggest optional wildlife and whale-watching trips. For shoppers, Government Street’s elegant shops and Market Square’s collection of specialty stores are good places to start. History buffs should be sure to visit the Royal British Columbia Museum. Enjoy dinner and the evening on your own at one of the many restaurants in this wonderful harbor city. **(B)**

May 29 – Vancouver, British Columbia

This morning we take the BC Ferry and sail through the Gulf Islands, an archipelago known for its Mediterranean-type climate. Upon arrival in Vancouver, enjoy a city tour including the harbor, beaches, Chinatown, historic Gastown and Stanley Park, with its towering evergreen forests and totem polls. Enjoy a special farewell dinner together this evening. **(B, D)**

May 30 – Return Home

After breakfast, we make our way to Vancouver International Airport for our return flight to Omaha. Upon arrival in Omaha, say goodbye to your fellow travelers and Moostash Joe Tour Director with many fond memories as you make it back to your original pick-up points. **(B)**
