## June 12 - Depart Omaha / Overnight flight en route

Meet us today at one of our many convenient pick-up points as we make our way to Omaha's Eppley Airfield and connect to our overnight flight to Venice, Italy.

#### June 13 - Venice, Italy

Welcome to Venice – the capital of Northern Italy's Veneto region and consistently ranked as one of the most beautiful cities in the world! This iconic Italian city is known as the "City of Canals", as it is situated on a group of over 100 small islands separated by canals. Transportation within the city itself largely remains as in centuries past, entirely on water or by foot. Upon arrival, we are met by our local tour guide and transferred by boat to the historic city center. Here, our local guide takes us on a walking tour of Venice with admission to St. Mark's Basilica – the iconic, landmark cathedral known for its incredible architecture. We also take time to tour nearby Doge's Palace with headsets before checking-in to our hotel right along the Grand Canal, where we'll all enjoy a three-course evening meal together. **(D)** 

#### June 14 - Embark the Norwegian Dawn

After breakfast and free time at your leisure this morning, we transfer by boat to the Venice Pier and embark on the Norwegian Dawn! Once on-board, you'll have the chance to explore your home for the next seven nights as the cruise departs port at 5:00 PM. **(B, D)** 

#### June 15 - Kotor, Montenegro

Tucked away between the mountains and the Bay of Kotor is where you'll find the picturesque town of Kotor. As you arrive in this secluded city, you'll notice the dramatic 65-foot high protective walls, which date back to the Venetian period during the 9th century. Stroll the labyrinth of cobbled streets with cozy cafes and craft shops as you marvel the graceful old buildings. Listed as a UNESCO World Natural and Historical Heritage Site, Kotor is also world-famous as a premier yachting and sailing destination. **(B, L, D)** 

#### June 16 - Corfu, Greece

One of the lushest of the Greek Isles, Corfu is rimmed in dramatic blue waters and topped with tranquil hillside villages. A collection of quaint cafes in the town of Corfu feels very continental, but the island's secluded coves and sandy beaches could only be found in the Greek Isles! **(B, L, D)** 

## June 17 - Santorini, Greece

Whitewashed villages clinging to the sides of the sea cliffs have made the volcanic island of Santorini one of the most widely photographed places in the world. The island's charm and subtle mystery have even made it a target of speculation as the location of the lost city of Atlantis. (B, L, D)

#### June 18 - Mykonos, Greece

Mykonos is a classic Greek Island with whitewashed houses, blue-domed churches and windmills. Add a reputation for beautiful beaches and you'll understand why Mykonos is the most popular island in the Cyclades. Choose one of the many optional shore excursions, from exploring the island in a 4×4 or taking a ferry to the tiny island of Delos. (B, L, D)

#### June 19 - Argostoli, Kefalonia, Greece

Looking at picturesque Argostoli, you wouldn't know it suffered a devastating earthquake in 1953. The city and its surrounding area are full of treasures, including a 12-century Byzantine cathedral and beautiful 16th-century frescoes. And the nearby underground Lake of Melissani is simply magical. Choose to enter the caves to find ancient stalactites and marvel at the scattered rays of light beaming through, turning the water an intense blue. **(B, L, D)** 

#### June 20 - Split, Croatia

This Mediterranean city on the eastern shores of the Adriatic has a long and eventful history dating back to the awesome Diocletian's Palace (circa 295 A.D.) in the center of the city. Split offers a wealth of exciting places to visit, from the majestic cathedral and marble streets in the center of town to the harbour area with its caf-lined promenades and views of coastal mountains. **(B, L, D)** 

#### June 21 - Disembark / Return Home

Welcome back to Venice! Enjoy one last breakfast on-board before disembarking the Norwegian Dawn. We then transfer to Venice Marco Polo Airport and our return flight to the United States. Upon arrival in Omaha, say goodbye to your fellow travelers and Moostash Joe Tour Director with many fond memories as you return back to your original pick-up points. (B)
