

Thursday, February 13 – Pre-Departure

If applicable, due to early flight times, pre-departure accommodations in Downtown Omaha at the Hilton Garden Inn are included. Pick-up times will be adjusted accordingly and information will be sent with your final travel documents.

Friday, February 14 – Depart Omaha/Arrive in Honolulu, HI

Depart this morning from one of our pick-up points to Omaha's Eppley Airfield. This afternoon, arrive in beautiful Honolulu, Hawaii with a traditional fresh flower Hawaiian Lei Greeting! Tonight, check-in to the Hyatt Place Hotel near famous Waikiki Beach and join your Tour Director for a welcome orientation and dinner featuring local Hawaiian cuisine. **(D)**

Saturday, February 15 – East Oahu Tour/Embark

After a breakfast buffet at the hotel, a narrated East Oahu Tour starts our adventure to the tropical windward side of Oahu. We will stop at Halona Blowhole, drive past Hanauma Bay and pass the beautiful town of Kaneohe. We will also make a stop at the Nuuanu Pali Lookout, for a gorgeous panoramic view of Oahu! After your tour, head to the Port of Honolulu and board Norwegian Cruise Line's newly refurbished "Pride of America!" Spend the rest of the day exploring your new home for the next seven nights! **(B, D)**

Sunday, February 16 - Kahului, Maui

Friday, February 21 – Nawiliwili, Kauai

Enjoy another day in paradise before you set sail in the afternoon. Don't miss the spectacular Na Pali Coast viewing on your way back to Honolulu. Spend one last night appreciating the delicious food

and variety of entertainment on board the "Pride of America!" **(B, L, D)**

Saturday, February 22 – Disembark/Pearl Harbor/Depart Honolulu, HI

Welcome back to Honolulu! morning, disembark the Pride of America, board your motor coach and take Honolulu City Tour, featuring Iolani Palace, King Kamehameha Statue, the Hawaii State Capitol and through China Town. the memorial. Witness the actual sunken hull where over 1000 servicemen were entombed during the December 7, 1941 sneak attack on Pearl Harbor. After your visit, board your transfer to Honolulu International Airport for your overnight flight back to the mainland. **(B)**
