Back for 2024! Journey through the very best of Ireland on this classic Irish adventure. Discover all of the can't-miss scenery and history, including the Cliffs of Moher, Blarney Castle, House of Waterford Crystal and so much more!

ITINERARY

August 11 – Depart Omaha / Overnight flight en route

Meet us today at one of our many convenient pick-up points as we make our way to Omaha's Eppley Airfield and connect to our overnight flight to Dublin, Ireland!

August 12 – Arrive in Dublin / Dublin City Tour

Cead mile failte! (The Irish Gaelic term meaning "a hundred thousand welcomes!"). Upon arrival we transfer to our hotel before setting out on a panoramic tour of the city. Highlights include 18th-century Georgian houses with brightly painted doors, tranquil parks, and historic O'Connell Street. Visit the Custom House, an architectural and historic gem built in 1791 on the Liffey quays, once Ireland's trade route to the world. In the evening, enjoy a welcome drink with your group before dinner at the hotel. **(D)**

August 13 – Glendalough / Dumbrody Famine Ship / Waterford

Enjoy the delightful scenery of the Wicklow Mountains on the way to Glendalough. Explore the remains of one of the most important monastic sites in Ireland, founded by St. Kevin in the 6th century. Walk through the deep valley to view the picturesque ruins of a round tower, churches, and Celtic crosses. Head southeast to the Dumbrody Famine Ship, an authentic reproduction of an 1840's vessel that brought desperate Irish emigrants fleeing famine to the New World. Continue on to Waterford and take a stroll around the streets of this historic city with a local guide before dinner. **(B, D)**

August 14 – Waterford Crystal / Cobh / Blarney Castle

See skilled artisans create crystal masterpieces at the House of Waterford Crystal! Then travel to Cobh for a guided walking tour – this harbor town was the last port of call for the Titanic in 1912 and was also the main point of embarkation for Irish emigrants between 1848 and 1960. Proceed on to Blarney to visit Blarney Castle and kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence" or explore the tranquil gardens. Journey west through the rugged countryside and settle in to your centrally located hotel in Killarney. **(B, D)**

August 15 – Ring of Kerry / Killarney

Discover Ireland's most popular scenic drive, the Ring of Kerry. Along the way we stop for lunch, take a stroll around Sneem, and stop at Moll's Gap to enjoy its panoramic views. Enjoy a free evening in Killarney, with time for dining on your own and perhaps a visit to one of the town's many lively pubs. **(B, L)**

August 16 – Cliffs of Moher / Galway

Head to the Cliffs of Moher, stunning formations that soar 700 feet above the churning Atlantic and extend for 9 miles. On the way, we take a ferry across the River Shannon Estuary and travel along the scenic coast of County Clare. Take in the spectacular views as you walk atop the cliffs. Travel on through the austere beauty of the Burren, a distinctive limestone landscape formed by glaciers, to Galway. A local guide will join us for a brief stroll through the medieval streets of this vibrant, artistic city. **(B, D)**

August 17 – Sheepdog Demonstration / Donegal / Derry

Immerse yourself in traditional farm life during our visit to an authentic working farm, where you'll watch trained sheepdogs round up mountain sheep. Continue through the rugged mountainous landscape to Donegal town and enjoy free time to explore. Proceed on to Derry, where a local guide will help discover this ancient walled city, long known for its tumultuous history but now a thriving artistic hub. **(B, D)**

August 18 – Giant's Causeway / Titanic Belfast / Glyde Inn

Explore the northern coastline and the Giant's Causeway, enormous hexagonal columns formed by volcanic activity over 60 million years ago. Visit Titanic Belfast and learn about the ill-fated ship through state-of-the-art displays. See the docks where the famous liner was built just over a century ago. Stop at the Glyde Inn for a farewell dinner with Irish specialties and entertainment featuring traditional Irish music and songs. **(B, D)**

August 19 – Independent Dublin Sightseeing

Today is your day to explore Dublin independently aboard the Hop-On, Hop-Off bus. Use your voucher to visit one of Dublin's top attractions: Teeling Whiskey Distillery, EPIC – The Irish Emigration Museum, or the GPO Museum. The evening is free to dine on your own at one of the many restaurants or pubs that Dublin has to offer. **(B)**

August 20 – Return Home

Transfer to Dublin Airport for our return flight back to the United States. Spend one last day reminiscing with your fellow travelers and newly made friends about your Irish Adventure! Upon arrival in Omaha say goodbye as you transfer back to your individual pick-up points. **(B)**
