Day 2 – Frankenmuth, MI

Mackinac Island is no ordinary island. Listed as a National Historic Landmark with a ban on all motor vehicles, this picturesque island is sure to leave feelings of nostalgia with its many bikes, old-time feel and charming shops. Our lunch buffet at the Grand Hotel is one you won't soon forget, but don't miss the dessert bar! Later, we meet our very own horse and carriage for a guided tour of the island, including unique commentary and the island's must-see stops. The tour ends on Main Street, where you'll have the remainder of the day to do whatever you like! Shop for the perfect gift, try the island's renowned fudge, enjoy an evening meal from a quaint cafe or stroll the waterfront! Tonight's accommodations are at the fabulous Mission Point Resort, voted one of the top resort hotels in the Midwest and sits right on the shores of Mackinac Island!
