ITINERARY

August 22 - Depart Omaha / Overnight flight en routeMeet us today at one of our many convenient pick-up points as we make our way to Omaha's Eppley Airfield and connect to our overnight flight to Dublin, Ireland!

August 23 - Arrive in Dublin / Blarney Castle & Stone Céad míle fáilte! (The Irish Gaelic term meaning "a hundred thousand welcomes!") Shortly after "touchdown" at Dublin Airport, we meet our local tour guide/driver who will welcome us to Ireland! Relax and get to know your fellow travelers on our drive to Blarney. Blarney is world-renowned for being the site of the Blarney Castle and famed "Stone

of Eloquence," where you'll get to climb its battlements and kiss the stone. From Blarney, journey through the rugged countryside to Killarney where we'll check-in for our two-night stay and enjoy a welcome dinner together. **(D)**

August 24 - Dingle Peninsula

Today, discover the beauties of the Dingle Peninsula, once described by National Geographic Traveler as "the most beautiful place on earth." Drive along the south shore of the peninsula for plenty of vistas of heathery mountains, sandy stretches of beach, stunning green landscapes and rocky headlands. We'll pause at strategic locations along the way to admire the views and take the best photos. This evening we return back to Killarney for a free evening to enjoy this welcoming Irish town on our own. **(B)**

August 25 - Cliffs of Moher

This morning we leave Killarney to Tarbert, where we take a short ferry ride across the River Shannon Estuary. Next, drive along the coast of County Clare to visit the Cliffs of Moher, which overlooks the shimmering Atlantic Ocean. Harry Potter and the Half Blood Prince along with the Princess Bride feature scenes that were filmed at this stunning landmark. Continue to the lively city of Limerick, where we'll be overnight, and spend some time to relax or freshen up before tonight's festivities! This evening, join in the fun and feasting at Bunratty or Knappogue Castle! Your medieval-style banquet is served in the Great Hall of the 15th century castle. **(B, D)**

August 26 - Galway / Scenic Irish Drive / Dublin

Today we meet a local guide for a gentle walking tour of Galway. See the medieval city walls, Lynch's Castle and its narrow streets. Then we leave Galway and travel across Ireland via the towns of Ballinasloe, Athlone and Moate, all marketing centers which serve their surrounding regions. Continue across the rolling pastures of Ireland's heartland to the greater metropolitan area of Dublin. Here we checkin for our three-night stay in Dublin where you can enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure to sight-see and have dinner on your own at one of the areas many terrific restaurants. Tonight is also the perfect night to make your last predictions for Nebraska Football over a drink at a local pub as tomorrow is game day! **(B)**

August 27 – Nebraska vs. Northwestern Football at Aviva Stadium

Go Big Red! Make sure you wear plenty of red today as we make our way to nearby Aviva Stadium to cheer on Nebraska as they kick-off their 2022 college football season against Northwestern! With a capacity of 51,700, Aviva Stadium opened in 2010 and is host to many international sporting events such as soccer and rugby as well as a venue for large concerts. Take your seats to what is hoped to be an epic match between these Big 10 rivals! This will be Nebraska Football's first game outside the United States since they played Kansas State in Tokyo, Japan back in 1992 – and you'll get to experience it LIVE! After the game you are free to enjoy the rest of the evening at your leisure, hopefully celebrating a Nebraska victory! **(B)**

August 28 - Hop on Hop off Dublin

Enjoy the day at your leisure in Dublin, where you can choose from a wide variety of activities. Use your included Hop on Hop off pass to visit a number of places. Your passes are also good for a visit to either the Guinness Storehouse or the General Post Office! If you choose to visit the Guinness Storehouse you'll see the exhibits on how this world famous stout was first created and enjoy a sample of the finished product. If you decide to visit the General Post Office on O'Connell Street, learn about its role in the Easter Rising and how it was left in ruins. There are also plenty of museums and shops you may like to visit before enjoying your last evening in Dublin on your own to make one last Irish memory! **(B)**

August 29 - Return Home

Transfer to Dublin Airport for our return flight back to the United States. Spend one last day reminiscing with your fellow travelers and newly made friends about your tour to see the highlights of Ireland and Nebraska vs. Northwestern Football! Upon arrival in Omaha say goodbye as you transfer back to your individual pick-up points. **(B)**

- FREE AIRFARE from Omaha offer is valid up until July 30, 2021. After this date, add an additional \$1,500 per person for airfare. Moostash Joe Tours will select group airfare arrangements that are most suitable and efficient when combined with our land arrangements. Round trip airfare will initially be requested out of Omaha to Dublin. Due to availability, some group airfare may depart from other cities other than Omaha. In this case, our group will be transported by deluxe motorcoach from Norfolk, Fremont, Lincoln and Omaha, NE to your designated departure city, with specific information sent in your final travel documents. Our group airfare will be scheduled to depart Omaha in the afternoon or evening of August 22, 2022. Moostash Joe Tours must receive a copy of the information (photo) page of your passport by August 31, 2021 and is recommended that your passport be valid for at least six months from the return date of your tour. After final payment, any changes to your reservation will incur a change fee. Moostash Joe Tours is unable to issue copies of airline tickets for passengers requesting to use frequent flyer miles. Seats for your flight are assigned at the airport gate. Seat upgrades are available upon request for an additional fee, based on availability and are not available to be requested until 60 days prior to departure, and on the terms of each individual airline carrier. Baggage fees will be the responsibility of the passenger and depend on each individual airline carrier. Due to our FREE AIRFARE from Omaha offer, we are unable to accommodate pre and post touring in Ireland. Flight information will be available approximately one month prior to departure and will be sent with your final travel documents.

request, tickets are obtained from ticket agencies and could be located in any part of the stadium, including upperend zones. Every attempt will be made to secure tickets in one section of the stadium for our group, however, tickets
may be in pairs or in groups of fours.
