ITINERARY

May 13 - Nebraska City / Spirit of Brownville

Welcome to Nebraska – the Good Life! Our all-inclusive tour starts at Werner Park for a look at the home of the Omaha Storm Chasers – the AAA affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. Then it's off to Nebraska City, where we'll tour the historic Arbor Lodge Mansion as well as enjoy the always-popular Discovery Ride! We'll check-in to the unique Lied Lodge before making our way to Brownville and the Spirit of Brownville for our scenic dinner cruise on the Missouri River! **(L, D)**

May 14 - Lincoln

This morning we'll take the short drive over to Lincoln – Nebraska's State Capital. Here we visit Robber's Cave, one of the cities most interesting and fascinating places. We'll also tour the State Capitol building, a must for any visitor to Lincoln. Lunch will be at the Green Gateau, Lincoln's trendy downtown bistro. On our way to Omaha, Nebraska's largest city, we'll stop at Baker's Candies in Greenwood, home to the famous chocolate meltaways and other sweet treats. Later this afternoon finds us at Holy Family Shrine. Just off of I-80, you've probably seen it but never had the chance to visit! We'll check-in to our overnight accommodations in upscale Regency neighborhood at the Omaha Marriott before making our way to the Polish Heritage Society for traditional Polish food and entertainment. **(B, L, D)**

May 15 - Boys Town / Omaha

This morning finds us at Father Flanagan's Boys Town. Founded in 1917, we'll learn about the exceptionally heartwarming story of how Father Flanagan worked to create a haven for wayward boys, and now girls, on the outskirts of Omaha. Next we'll tour St. John the Baptist Greek Orthodox Church – Omaha's only Greek Orthodox Byzantine-style church – followed by a traditional Greek lunch. This afternoon we visit Omaha's must-see attractions, the Durham Museum and Lauritzen Gardens. To finish our tour of the Good Life, we head to the German American Society for delicious comfort food followed by traditional German entertainment, before saying goodbye to our new friends at our original pick-up points! **(B, L, D)**
