November 7 - Travel Day / Elkhart, IN

Meet your Moostash Joe Tour Director and Driver at one of our many convenient pick-up points this morning and head east! Our travels take us through Iowa, Illinois and to Elkhart, IN where we'll be overnight.

November 8 - Hershey, PA

Today, continue east through Ohio and the beautiful Pennsylvania countryside to Hershey, PA. Enjoy an evening meal together at Fenicci's, a local Italian favorite. **(B, D)**

November 9 - Pennsylvania Amish Country / Philadelphia, PA

This morning we take the short drive to Lancaster, PA and the Mennonite Information Center. Here we meet our local stepon guide, of Mennonite or Amish heritage, for a guided tour of Pennsylvania Amish Country. Lancaster County is known for its abundance of Mennonite and Amish as well as being the home of the oldest existing Amish settlement in the world! After our tour we enjoy a delicious authentic Pennsylvania Dutch lunch at the Birdin-Hand Family Restaurant & Smorgasbord. This afternoon finds us in Philadelphia to meet our local step-on guide for a guided city tour of the city commonly known as "The City of Brotherly Love." Later this evening, our day ends in Lyndhurst, NJ for our five-night stay just outside of New York City. **(B, L, D)**

November 10 - NYC Touring / Broadway Show

Good morning and welcome to the "Big Apple!" A day full of fun activities await! We'll meet our local step-on guide as we make our way around Manhattan, making our first stop for our Backstage Tour at the famed Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts – home to New York's most prominent performing groups. We'll enjoy lunch together before our next stop at the iconic Empire State Building for a birds-eye view of the city at the 86th Floor Observation Deck! Our touring this afternoon takes us to Grand Central Terminal and Times Square, where you'll have time to enjoy the bright lights and one of New York's many fabulous restaurants on your own before our Broadway Show, The Lion King! **(B, L)**

November 11 - NYC Touring

Back in the city, our morning includes visits to Trump Tower, Harlem, Central Park and the Upper West Side. Lunch is included before our stop at the Metropolitan Museum of Art, also known as "the Met," which is the largest art museum in the United States and third most visited in the world. November 13 - NYC Touring

Our day starts out with a driving tour through Greenwich Village and SoHo before we stop to visit the 9/11 Museum and 9/11 Memorial Park – a must for any visitor.
