Friday, March 29 – Pre-Departure

If applicable, due to early flight times, pre-departure accommodations in Downtown Omaha at the Hilton Garden Inn are included. Pick-up times will be adjusted accordingly and information will be sent with your final travel documents.

Saturday, March 30 - Depart Omaha/Arrive in Los Angeles, CA/Embark

Later this morning, arrive in the City of Angels, transfer to the Los Angeles Cruise Terminal and board the Norwegian Star!
