



Peace of Mind Policy

Since starting operations in 1975, we have always focused on putting our travelers first in everything we do. Our number one priority is the safety and well-being of our guests. Along with our motorcoach partner, Arrow Stage Lines, we have confidently implemented the following temporary policies and procedures to put your health first, get back on the road and continue to help others discover the wonder and majesty of God's creation through travel.

- Motorcoach tours will be limited to 50% capacity.
 - To encourage social distancing, motorcoaches will be limited to a maximum of 26 travelers.
- Travelers will receive a full refund on all motorcoach tours, for any reason, up until the day before departure.
- Travelers will be required to bring their own mask but will be optional to wear on the motorcoach.
 - Limiting the capacity of the motorcoach will ensure social distancing, but certain vendors (attractions, hotels, restaurants, etc.) may require wearing a mask.
- Travelers will be required to sign a waiver limiting liability and acknowledging good personal health prior to beginning your tour.
- Tour Drivers and Tour Directors will be required to maintain proper social distancing by limiting contact with passengers.
- Hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes will be available on the motorcoach and available to all guests. Tour Drivers and Tour Directors will pay close attention to the sanitization of commonly touched areas throughout each day.
- If a passenger or driver starts showing symptoms of an illness while on a multi-day tour, Arrow Stage Lines and Moostash Joe Tours will be notified immediately. Action will be determined on a case-by-case basis.
