




Sioux Falls Christmas

ITINERARY

December 3 - Falls Park / Olde Towne Dinner Theatre

Welcome to your "Deck the Falls" Christmas Tour! Meet us at one of our many convenient pick up points as we make our way to Sioux Falls, SD. As South Dakota's largest city, Sioux Falls offers a wealth of fun activities and transforms into a spectacular winter wonderland during Christmastime! Upon arrival, a welcome lunch will be at local favorite spot, Grille 26, before beginning to explore the city. Our first stop is for a guided tour of the Cathedral of Saint Joseph, standing tall above the Sioux Falls skyline as one of the city's notable landmarks. We meet our local, step-on guide here and make our way to incredible Falls Park! Winter turns the 123-acre park into a wonderland of breathtaking lights. Spend some time here to admire the city's namesake and enjoy birds-eye views from atop the five-story viewing tower. Also at the park we'll tour the Stockyards Ag Experience Barn, telling the story of agriculture's impact in this region. Then, check-in to our accommodations for the next two nights and spend time to relax and freshen up before our evening out! Tonight we take our seats in the nearby town of Worthing, SD and enjoy great food and entertainment for the Olde Towne Dinner Theatre Holiday Show! This small community theatre is the longest continually running theatre in the Sioux Falls area, where the actors, cast and crew, wait staff and even bartenders are all volunteers! (L, D)

December 4 - McCrossan Boys Ranch Tour / Old Madrigal Feast

This morning we continue our sightseeing in the city and tour both the Old Courthouse Museum and Pettigrew Home & Museum. Richard F. Pettigrew was South Dakota's first full-term U.S. senator and purchased the home in 1911, which features many unique artifacts from all over the world. Later this morning finds us just outside the city at the McCrossan Boys Ranch. For more than 61 years, the McCrossan Boys Ranch has been dedicated to providing a place for boys to grow into men, reaching out to boys between the ages of nine to twenty who have experienced conflict in their lives. Our tour includes a homemade lunch along with a chance to learn about the values, goals, education and skills that they prepare them for life outside the Ranch. This afternoon includes a tour and wine tasting at nearby Strawbale Winery to discover their beautiful country setting and unique, innovative way of producing and storing great wine. Later we stop to tour the U.S. Geological Survey Earth Resources Observation and Science Center, housing one of the largest computer complexes in the entire Department of the Interior. Back in downtown, take a BREW break as you're able to spend some time at one of four breweries all well within walking distance, before time to relax and refresh at our hotel to get ready for another evening out! Tonight finds us at the University of Sioux Falls for their Madrigal Dinner Feast! These annual dinner theatre performances combine vocal and instrumental music, dancing, drama, elegant Renaissance garb and fine dining. (B, L, D)

December 5 - Good Earth State Park / Augustana University Christmas Vespers / Return Home

Another full day of exciting holiday-themed activities await! This morning visit Good Earth State Park, one of South Dakota's newest state parks before spending the rest of the morning back downtown to explore the SculptureWalk, Arc of Dreams and 605 Made Holiday Market. Early this afternoon you'll have the chance to explore Washington Pavilion, the region's home for the arts, entertainment and science. Our time in Sioux Falls comes to an end, but not before the beautiful and very popular Christmas Concert featuring Augustana University's four choirs, orchestra, brass and organ at Our Saviors Lutheran Church. After the concert we begin to head south but not without enjoying one last meal together in Sioux City before returning back home with many wonderful Christmas memories from our "Deck the Falls" Sioux Falls Christmas Tour! **(B, D)**
