

We'll visit Harp Design Co, including a driving tour of some of Chip and Joanna's fixed-up houses! After our tour, we head to the renowned Magnolia Market at the Silos - as seen on the hit HGTV show "Fixer Upper." Here, you can browse their unique collection of home decor, try a famous cupcake from the Magnolia Bakery, explore Magnolia Seed + Supply, relax on the lawn and enjoy lunch from the best food trucks in Waco! For those that finished their shopping early or want to keep exploring, choose to spend your afternoon taking advantage of the free Silo District Downtown Trolley, which makes it easy to get to Waco's most popular downtown shops, museums and restaurants.
